Living support was provided to 84 individuals in our 24/7 staffed group homes, while 67 individuals received staff assistance to help them live independently in apartments or condominiums.

Our 21-group home and activity vans covered 315,000 miles this year, ensuring program participants stayed active and engaged in the community. From classes and doctors appointments to dance classes and church/synagogue services our wheels are always turning.

Provided assistance to over 400 individuals, covering expenses such as rent, utilities, therapy sessions, car repairs, and more through our First In Families project.




